Why is Sister Cinthia Mahoney, a nun who had moved from South Carolina to New York, considered a hero?	She was trained as an EMT and she spent six months helping at Ground Zero and was called the Angel of Ground Zero
What does anonymously mean?	Something is done by an unknown person
What does chaotic mean?	A state of confusion and disorder
What does commotion mean?	Noisy excitement and confusion
What does debris mean?	Pieces of something broken

What is an EMT?	An emergency medical technician - someone trained to give medical care to someone until they can get to a hospital.
